

Significance of different rituals to be conducted during Nava Chandika Homam:

- 1. Shodasa Mathruka Poojai: Invoking the 16 godly mothers to seek special blessings before commencing the great yagam.
- 2. Yanthra Sthapanam: Sarvatho Bhadra Mandalam-invoking all the 33 crore devathas with Chandika Parameshwari as the main deity and Sapthasathi Yanthram-invoking the Sapthasathi Saraswathi specially to guard the Chandi Homam while the 700 ahuthis are offered to Goddess Chandika chanting the Sapthasathi. (Devi Mahatmyam).
- 3. Kalasha Sthapanam: Totally 14 kalashams will be installed invoking the 13 Adhyaya Devathas and Chandika Parameshwari as the main kalasham, for which specific namavalis will be chanted along with ashtotharam for Maha Kali, Maha Lakshmi, Maha Saraswathi and Chandika Parameshwari.
- 4. Navavarana Poojai: Invoking the parivara devathas in nine circles of the yanthram with archanas and tharpanams.
- 5. Sapthasathi Parayanam: All rithwiks will do the parayanam together including Kavacham, Argalam, Keelakam along with 13 adhyayams.
- 6. Yogini and Bhairava Bali: A special ritual to invoke and please all the rudra devathas of Chandi to remove all possible obstacles arising in the Yagam. It also pacifies the kshudra shakthis which may be afflicting some people.

Smt. Savita Sreeram. (The Abhang Bhajan Artist for 12th April 2012)
